Unfortunately, the shop was closed in 1999, but not without the lasting memories and friendships that formed in the picturesque heart of Scottsdale.

Consistent with Gra-Wan Jewelers, most of the merchants along 5th Avenue operate family owned shops. A wide variety of services are available, including, retail shops, museums, theaters, galleries, restaurants, bars, and nightclubs.
